

MN ASSOCIATION OF CHARTER SCHOOL – NEW LAW PRIMER 2023

NEW: SHORT-CALL SUBSTITUTE TEACHER PILOT PROGRAM - (MN Statutes 122A.441)

A school district or charter school and an applicant can jointly request PLESB approve an application for a short-call substitute teaching license.

- Applicant **must meet one of the following** requirements:
 - Possess an associate degree or equivalent & receive training from the school
 - Possess a high school diploma or equivalent (i.e. GED) & been employed as an education support professional or para in the school for at least one year
- School must complete a background check & provide training.
- School must pay a minimum compensation of the greater of \$200 per day or the employee's regular rate of pay.
